

# Indonesian

Welcome back Comet Bay families! We've come to Term 3, another busy and exciting term in Indonesian.

The Year 2/3 students will continue to explore more about 'Keluarga' (Family) and learn about 'Pakaian' (Clothes) later in the term. Students will be able to describe clothing using colours, numbers and other simple adjectives.

The Year 4/5 students will be learning about 'Ayo ke sekolah' (Let's go to school). Students will compare the similarities and differences between schools in Australia and Indonesia. They will use Indonesian to name some classroom items, discuss and describe school routines, places at school and the activities that take place there using simple descriptive language.
