This includes a wide brimmed hat other than their school hat and footwear if your child does not want to participate barefoot (eg, gumboots). If your child will be ok barefoot please ensure your child has their regular shoes on when they arrive at school.
- Ensure you pack school uniform for them to change into after the incursion is complete.
- Bring a towel and a plastic bag for muddy clothes.
- **Please ensure that all of your child's items are clearly labelled with their name.**

The cost of the incursion will be **\$9.00**. We will require payment by no later than the **1st of April**. Please complete the attached permission slip and return it with payment in the attached envelope to your child's teacher on or before the due date.

The Messy Mud Day Incursion will be an extremely rewarding activity for the students. We look forward to having a fun filled day with many memories that will be shared and hopefully some more lasting memories created.
