Class Preparation

Teachers have started the process of making sure all students feel comfortable about going to camp, explaining what will happen when we are there and ensuring all feel safe and included. Students have been consulted about their room allocations and staff have ensured each student is placed with at least one of their selected friends. If you have any concerns about your child on camp please talk to your child's teacher or a staff member who will be attending camp.

Booklet

A booklet with further camp information will be sent home early next term. This will include details of what to pack (clothing, toiletries etc.), day groups, room groups, activities time schedules etc.

School Uniform

School uniforms are not required for this camp, students will not be leaving SVAC and will require comfortable clothing for daily activities.

Camp Consent

Please complete and sign the general consent form (including RAT consent) accompanying this letter. This is due back by Friday 24th June 2022.

COVID-19

Students and staff will need to provide evidence (e.g. photo) of a negative RAT taken on the morning of the camp, prior to attending or provide evidence they are within the 12 weeks of being a recovered COVID-19 case – this can be provided at any stage prior to camp. Staff and students who are asymptomatic close contacts can still attend camp provided they have a daily RAT that is negative (staff and students) and wear masks (staff only).

A supply of RAT's will be taken on camp by the excursion supervisor and be available for use should a child become unwell or symptomatic. Should your child test positive whilst on camp they will be isolated from others, a parent will be contacted and requested to pick the child up from the camp site. Please note, as previously indicated, we are bound by Health and Department of Education guidelines. Plans may change or be altered if required due to the current situation with COVID-19 closer to the date of camp.
